ADMISSIONS POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Cyber-Ed Christian School of Excellence admits students without regard to their race, color, religion, or national origin. However, academics are taught from a Christian worldview. Students attending Cyber-Ed Christian School of Excellence are expected to be obedient and to respect authority.

Students who have been expelled or asked to leave other schools because of poor disciplinary records will not be admitted to Cyber-Ed Christian School of Excellence. Such students must wait at least one year and compile a good disciplinary record before their application will be considered.

In general, it is desired that students admitted to Cyber-Ed Christian School of Excellence possess the following characteristics:

- ❖ A respect for God's Word
- ❖ An ability to admit and accept responsibility for wrongs committed
- Courteous and polite behavior
- ❖ A teachable spirit
- ❖ A well-rounded interest in activities beyond the classroom

New students are required to take a placement test and submit the following information:

- Application and Release Form
- Parental Agreement
- Emergency Medical Release Form
- Certification of immunization and birth certificate
- Standardized test scores and transcripts (For students coming from overseas)
- Last report card

After all the above information is received, the Executive Director reviews this information and determines the student's eligibility.

Please note that students entering the first grade for the 2019/2020 school year must be six years old by December 31, 2019.
